## ***Yai and I are coming to America***

After several years of being away, Yai and I will be coming to America in December. Since we rarely come to the USA, we plan to stay longer than usual. We will spend three months traveling around the United States speaking at churches, pastors' meetings, small groups, home fellowships and visiting many of those whom we love and hold dear.

Although the Lord has sent us to the Nations, much of my burden has always been for Christians in America. Because of this we are preparing a condensed, fast paced, highly interactive version of the workshops we teach pastors overseas called "*HUB - The Center of Christian Living*" (HUB = **H**ow to **U**nderstand the **B**ible.) This streamlined version will contain similar teachings to the pastors' workshops held overseas, but instead of using scriptures which are ministry related we use some of the Bible passages related to Christian life which are often misunderstood.

***Beware!*** This new version designed for Christian lay-people, may permanently change the way they study and understand what they read in the Bible. They will never view scripture the same again.


*'The best way to learn how to do something is to do it.'* When a person is told how to do a thing it is just theory sitting in the brain waiting to be used someday. Once we do something over and over again, we remember how we did it and it becomes a part of us. If we continue doing it, it then becomes second nature to us.

In these participatory workshops, students do not have to memorize procedures and techniques. Instead, we use questions designed to make the participants learn and practice using each principle, technique, and procedure as they are being taught. When our workshop ends the student will have practiced and used each of the principles taught in that class several times. By then it will have begun to be a part of the way they think and analyze the Bible. If they then continue using what they have learned, these skills will become second nature to them and they will gain a greater understanding of the Bible every time they study it.

## **H. U. B.**

### **How to Understand the Bible**

In these workshops participants gain the skills they need to use the Bible to find everything they should know about living a Godly Christian life.



We are preparing two versions of H. U. B..

- A ten-hour version entitled “*10 Hours to a Better Understanding.*”  
These workshops give participants the basic skills they need to understand most Bible passages they have questions about. In this class students also learn how to take any teaching they have heard about a passage and find out if it matches scripture. These workshops can be taught in one day or divided into four, 2<sup>1/2</sup> hour evening sessions.
- A twenty-hour version entitled “*20 Hours to a More Perfect Understanding.*”  
These workshops not only teach participants basic skills of interpretation but also many of the finer ones as well. These workshops are good for any who desire to press on toward a deep understanding of God and His Word. These workshops can be taught as an intensive weekend course, (Friday night, all day Saturday, and Sunday afternoon and evening) or broken up into smaller segments to be taught on a more relaxed schedule. (*Example: Eight, 2<sup>1/2</sup> hour evening classes spread over two weeks*)

*No group too small:* We especially enjoy small groups where we can interact one on one with the people. However, it is not necessary to organize a group of people, if any of you would like us to simply drop by let us know. As long as we can work it into our schedule we are willing to come. We can personally visit and fellowship with you and give a personal update about the work God is doing among the nations; teach at your church, (*beside the HUB classes we can teach short in-depth topical studies lasting only a few hours each*) or greet your home group.



We have just begun planning our trip, so if you would like us to come through your area please let us know as soon as possible. Once we know, we will begin trying to work it into the schedule.
